max. 6 competitors/national team in each class

Relay: Women, Men

As much teams as possible in men's and women's class for each nation

Races for team officials

Terrain Description

- Low mountain range area with steep slopes
- Many rock formations and stones
- Varying runnability
- Irregular path network

Parts of the planned competition area were used in 2004 for the World Cup finals in the long distance and relay races.

Training

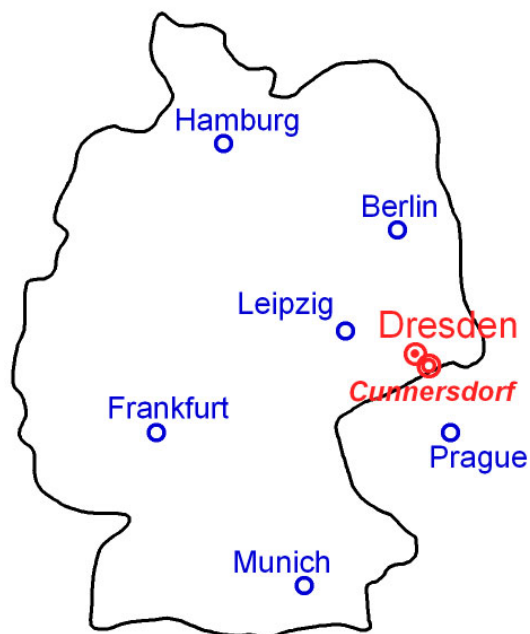
